

PHOTO SHOOT #8

For this Photo Shoot you will submit two photos. Each photo will be produced at 300 dpi and sized to 8x10 inches. You will include a paper copy of your complete write up which must include all camera settings (ISO< Fstop, shutter speed).

Photo #1 Light Painting

For this photo you must use a flashlight or similar instrument to light the main objects of the photos. You may position the light from any angle, but the light must be in motion for at least a portion of the exposure. Your write up must show several versions of what you tried to do. The final photo may be processed in either LR or PS.



Photo #2 HDR (High Definition Range)

This photo may be taken either at night or in full daylight. The important thing to remember is that the subject should have a wide range of tones (deep shadows to bright light) You will need to take at least 5 (FIVE) photos of your subject. One shot will be taken at the correct exposure then you will take one shot at one stop under exposed, one shot at 2 stops under exposed, one shot at one stop over exposed, and one shot at 2 stops over exposed.. It is important to remember that when you make changed you only change shutter speed. If you change fstop your depth of field will be affected. You must include all shots on your flash drive when the project is turned in. Photos must be processed in PS
