

PICTURE IN PICTURE



This is a quick tutorial to assist you in place a PICTURE INSIDE of another picture or a line of text. This is designed to give you the quick and simple basics. You will have to make adjustments for your particular application.

First you will need to have two images open in Photoshop: The image you want to paste something into and the image you want to paste into the first image.

1. Open the image you want to paste INTO. Get a selection tool from the Photoshop toolbox. Note, any selection tool will work, you will have to select the one that give you the result you need.
2. Make your selection. In the photo at the bottom of this page I used the rectangular selection tool to select the cell phone screen.
3. After making your selection, leave the selection active and switch to your second image, the one you want to paste into the first image. Use command –A to select the entire image, then command – C to copy the image into memory.
4. Return to your first image (you should still have an active selection on the image). Go to Edit and scroll down to Paste Into. The image will now appear inside the selection you made.
5. Go to the Move tool in the Photoshop Toolbox and then place your cursor on the pasted into image. Click and hold and you can move the image in any direction inside the selected area of your first image.
